**Let's Talk About Water** (LTAW) is a unique program combining the power of film and the science of water to inform and engage students, faculty and the general public in active discussion about water issues and solutions.

We have four goals:

- 1. To bring clarity and understanding to the water crisis and its solutions.
- 2. To facilitate conversation between experts and students, and provide a forum for debate around water science and policy.
- 3. To promote water and earth science education.
- 4. To engage general citizenry in public policy and water solutions.

The Challenge Grant Program helps support universities in the development of their own Let's Talk About Water water science outreach events. The Challenge Grant program is awarded on a dollar for dollar matching basis - meaning that CUAHSI matches funds raised by the university (up to \$3,000). Since its pilot year in 2012, CUAHSI has awarded Challenge grants to 17 Universities in the U.S. and Canada.

Applications for a new round of challenge grant funding will be accepted in the Fall of 2016!
